Arrival Instructions for Yokohama Hotel (September 2025 NPB Tour)

If you land at Haneda Airport (HND)...

Option 1: Taxi

Haneda Airport is close to our hotel – about 20 minutes by car. You can simply take a taxi from the taxi stand at Haneda. It will cost about \$70-\$100 (remember – no tipping!) and is the easiest option. Allow the driver to open the door for you at the beginning and end of your ride. You can also book private transfer via <u>Klook</u>, though that costs about \$150-\$200.

Option 2: Limousine Bus

If you're feeling a bit more adventurous and want to save some money, you can do as the locals do and take the airport limousine bus, operated by Keikyu. The cost is ¥1,000 (about \$7) and the travel time is about 40 minutes, including a 10 minute walk (just under half a mile) from the bus stop to the hotel.

Upon landing at Terminal 3 and exiting into the arrivals hall, stop by the Keikyu Airport Limousine bus ticket counter on the second floor. There is also a vending machine in the arrivals lobby and more machines by the first floor bus stops, but we suggest going to the counter so that you can talk to an attendant.

You want a bus going to Kanagawa Prefecture, specifically the bus with a final destination of Red Brick Warehouse that stops at **Osanbashi-iriguchi [Osanbashi Pier]**. On weekdays, your bus departs every 30-60 minutes from Terminal 3 (International Terminal) and then stops at Terminals 1 and 2 before starting its journey to Yokohama:

8:40, 9:40, 10:10, 10:40, 11:40, 12:40, 13:40, 14:40, 15:30, 16:40, 18:10, 19:10

Purchase your ticket and proceed to the corresponding bus stop on the first floor.

Confirm with the driver/attendant before boarding that this bus stops at Osanbashiiriguchi. Load your luggage and board the bus. After about 30-35 minutes, get off at Osanbashi-iriguchi [Osanbashi Pier] (<u>Google maps link</u>). Notify the driver in advance and pay attention during the ride, as this stop may be skipped if no one requests it.

You now have a 650m walk to the hotel (<u>Google maps link of walking directions</u>). From the bus stop, continue in the same direction the bus was traveling to the end of the block, where the road starts to curve left. Take a 90-degree left turn, walking perpendicular from the shores of Tokyo Bay. Stay straight 7-8 blocks. When you reach Yokohama Stadium on your right, the hotel is to your left.

If you land at Narita Airport (NRT)...

Option 1: Taxi or Private Transfer

The drive from Narita Airport to our hotel takes around 1.5-2hrs, depending on traffic. A taxi is pricey, but convenient. It would cost about \$250 on the meter from the airport taxi stand or about \$225 if you book private transfer via Klook.

Option 2: Narita Express

For a more economical option, take the Narita Express train and then a very short taxi ride to the hotel. Trains run every 30-60 minutes from approximately 7:45 AM to 9:45 PM and the duration is about 90 minutes. The cost of the train is $\pm 4,370$ (about ± 40) and the taxi will be about $\pm 2,300-\pm 2,800$ ($\pm 15-\pm 20$). Total travel time is likely under two hours.

After going through customs, head downstairs towards the trains. Look for the Narita Express (N'EX) ticket window. Purchase a ticket for Yokohama Station on train bound for Ofuna). Note that all tickets are for a reserved seat, so make sure you know what time your train departs and what car and seat you're assigned to.

After about 90 minutes, get off at Yokohama Station. Proceed to the taxi stand and take a taxi to our hotel. Allow the driver to open the door for you at the beginning and end of your ride. The ride will be under five minutes. Remember – no tipping!
