If you land at Haneda Airport (HND)...

Option 1: VIP-Style Private Transfer

Be one of those lucky travelers who has a driver waiting for them with a sign with their name on it in the airport arrivals hall! A private transfer is the perfect stress-free start to your vacation after a long flight. Option 2: Taxi

Haneda Airport is close to our hotel – about 30-35 minutes by car. You can simply take a taxi from the taxi stand at Haneda. It will cost about \$30-\$50 (remember – no tipping!). Allow the driver to open the door for you at the beginning and end of your ride.

Option 3: Train

If you're feeling a bit more adventurous and want to save some money, you can take the train. It only costs a few bucks and the journey is 10-15 minutes.

Exit the arrival gate and follow the signs to the Keikyu Line train station. Purchase a ticket for Shinagawa Station and take the Keikyu Airport Line (Limited Express or Rapid). Once you arrive at Shinagawa Station, follow the signs for the Shinagawa Prince Hotel.

Upon arrival at Shinagawa Station:

- Take the West ("Takanawa") Exit. Note that there is an elevator at the top of the stairs to the left.
- When you reach the massive crosswalk, look up and across the street for the "Prince Hotel" tower. That is your destination.
- Cross the street towards the escalators but don't take them; stay on the path to the left of the escalators on the street level.
- Follow signs to the Shinagawa Prince Hotel's Main Lobby.

If you land at Narita Airport (NRT)...

Option 1: VIP-Style Private Transfer

Be one of those lucky travelers who have a driver waiting for them with a sign with their name on it in the airport arrivals hall! A private transfer because it is the perfect stress-free start to your vacation after a long flight. Option 2: Taxi

The drive from Narita Airport to our hotel takes 1.5-2hrs, depending on traffic. A taxi is pricey, but convenient. It costs about \$180-\$200 on the meter (no tipping!) from the airport taxi stand. Allow the driver to open/close your door at the beginning and end of your ride.

Option 3: Public Transportation

You have two convenient options for public transit: the Narita Express train or the Airport Limousine bus. Both are \$20-\$25 per person. The bus is more comfortable with luggage and drops you directly at the hotel but only departs three times a day. The ride is approximately 90 minutes door-to-door. The train is at least 20 minutes faster and departs every 30 minutes, but not quite as comfortable with luggage.

- Exit the arrival gate at Narita Airport and look for signs for the limousine bus.
- Find the ticket window to purchase a ticket that stops at Shinagawa (also stops at Yokohama City Terminal, Haneda, and Ebisu).
- Allow the staff to load your luggage under the bus.
- Get off at Shinagawa Prince Hotel.

3b: Narita Express Train

- From the arrivals hall, go downstairs and find the JR Narita Express (N'EX) ticket window. Purchase a ticket.
- Proceed to the platform. Your ticket is a reserved seat, so note the car and seat assigned to you.

- Take the Narita Express (N'EX) train to Shinagawa Station. You do not need to change trains. Just stay on the Narita Express until you reach Shinagawa Station.
- Upon arrival at Shinagawa Station:
 - Take the West ("Takanawa") Exit. Note that there is an elevator at the top of the stairs to the left.
 - When you reach the massive crosswalk, look up and across the street for the "Prince Hotel" tower. That is your destination.
- Cross the street towards the escalators but don't take them; stay on the path to the left of the escalators on the street level.
- Follow signs to the Shinagawa Prince Hotel's Main Lobby.
